## Criteria

**Applicants are to attach a written submission addressing the following criteria and provide supporting documentation where applicable:**

- That they have enrolled or are intending to enrol in a tertiary course at an approved higher education provider in Brisbane (e.g. Queensland University of Technology, the University of Queensland, Trinity College Queensland, Griffith University or South Bank TAFE).
- That they are undertaking a full-time load of three subjects or more. Students undertaking a single subject or a non-award course (e.g. study abroad or exchange) are not eligible.
- Demonstrating outstanding academic achievement. This should be supported by a minimum of the previous year's academic results (Year 11 and 12 results for new students or full academic transcript for returning students).
- Demonstrating student leadership skills and community involvement would be advantageous.
- A reference from your school principal/course coordinator.
