

2022 COLLEGE FEES INFORMATION

Please find below information regarding College fees, additional charges, and payment options. This information needs to be read in conjunction with the 2022 Fee Schedule.

1. Contracted Weeks in 2022

Raymont accommodates students from all four major universities (QUT, UQ, Griffith, ACU) and all other accredited tertiary institutions in Brisbane. We have contract periods to cater for this diversity. Our main contract periods reflect the major university calendars. For institutions that have different academic periods than those listed below, we will provide a personalised contract period and fee schedule.

The contract period includes the mid-semester and mid-year breaks, and students do not need to vacate their room during the contract period. No credit is given for periods of absence from College during the contract period.

Summer Vacation Rate

Students who arrive prior to 13/02/22 and stay after the 21/11/22 will be charged a reduced student summer vacation rate of \$60 per night including food.

3. Payment Options

Payment Option 3 allows fees to be paid by fortnightly direct debit instalments. Raymont uses PaySmart, Australia's leading direct debit company, to administer all direct debit payment plans. The PaySmart instalment plans are on Page 2 of the 2022 Fee Schedule. If you wish to use PaySmart please email admin@raymont.com.au to request a PaySmart plan and a link will be emailed to you to activate your plan.

Note 1: Option 3 (PaySmart instalments) still requires the payment of a \$500 enrolment deposit and, for new students, the \$190 Orientation Activity Fee to be paid direct to the college using one of the above payment methods.

Note 2: PaySmart charge an \$11 initial set-up fee plus a \$5.50 transaction fee per fortnightly payment. These charges are deducted by PaySmart at the same time as the instalments.

5. Payment Terms

The Enrolment deposit is payable by new and returning students to secure a room. It is non-refundable, however it is applied to the annual fee account.

Fees must be received by the published due dates. Commencement is subject to the Enrolment Deposit, Residential Fees, and other charges being paid by the due date.

The termination of contracts and refunds are only granted at the discretion of the Principal, and only in exceptional circumstances.
