Accommodation

Our rooms are well proportioned and individually secured. Each room contains:

- a long single bed
- a study desk, chair and bookshelves
- a built-in wardrobe with chest of drawers
- a ceiling fan
- unlimited wi-fi (available throughout the college)

Your room is part of a unit. Each unit has 8 or 9 bedrooms with shared bathrooms, a common lounge equipped with a TV and lounge chairs plus a kitchenette area that has a dining setting, fridge,

microwave, kettle, sandwich maker and toaster. These shared facilities together with a laundry, ironing board and iron ensure that you have everything you need to live well.

We invite residents to bring their own linen so that they feel at home in their room.

We don't require residents to vacate their rooms during mid-semester or mid-year breaks.

We can provide accommodation (and meals) for students who arrive before or depart after the academic year to fit with their study or work commitments, especially over the summer.

Meals

Don't worry about having to prepare and cook your own meals—enjoy three home-cooked meals per day from our 4-star food safety rated kitchen. You can choose a variety of meals from our rotating menus. **RAYMONT** caters for all dietary requirements including allergies, vegetarian and vegan, and we do our best to meet the individual needs of students and student meal preferences. We also host special dinners throughout the year. This is all included as part of your fees!



Location

RAYMONT is conveniently located in the inner-city suburb of Auchenflower, with modern and safe public transport within walking distance.

It is only a short ride to Brisbane city, South Bank, QUT Kelvin Grove and Gardens Point, UQ St Lucia, Griffith University and the Conservatorium at South Bank and other tertiary institutions including TAFE Queensland, SAE and JMC Academy.
